

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

The wheat arrival in the grain market is down by 58 per cent in Hisar district as compared to the corresponding period in the previous year. The farmers think that the wheat prices are likely to go up in the next few weeks. So, most of the farmers are stocking the new produce as of now. The international market has high demand for wheat from India due to the Russia-Ukraine war.

As of 11th April, the government procurement under RMS 2022-23 stood at 20.55 LMT. The procurement in Punjab is 7.85 LMT with a record 2.15 LMT purchase on 10th April. In Haryana, the procurement is 7.68 LMT and 4.96 LMT in Madhya Pradesh.

In Punjab, the wheat procurement is largely bought by the flour millers. As per the sources, the yield in Punjab is expected to fall by 10-20 percent. The quality of wheat arriving is not good as most of the grains have shrunken its size.

In Kota and Bundi, the quality of crop arriving is rated poor compared to previous year. The arrivals are already in peak in Rajasthan and is expected to reduce from April 17th. The yield in Rajasthan is expected to fall by 8-10% as per sources.

In Uttar Pradesh, the yield is expected to fall by 10-15% as per sources. There is no issue regarding moisture for the arrived crops, though the quality of crop being reported is average to poor. The poor quality is being purchased by the government and good quality going to trader's hands.

As per sources, India has entered into contracts for exports of 30-35 LMT of wheat during April-July. Agriwatch has already estimated India's exports to reach 4-5 MMT during April to July period.

In Punjab, around 5.5 LMT of wheat has arrived as of now and 4.3 LMT of wheat has been purchased. In some districts, the arrivals have started to pick up and is expected to peak after Baisakhi or 15th April.

As per trade sources, 35,000 MT of wheat vessel AFRICAN VENTURE is loading at Kandla Port since 09th April 2022. And 28,000 MT of wheat vessel CHRISTIANA is loading at Kandla Port since 08th April 2022. And 55,000 MT of wheat vessel GLOBAL BRAVE is loading at Kandla Port since 08th April 2022. And 33,000 MT of wheat vessel HPC SUNRISE is loading at Kandla Port since 07th April 2022. And 32,000 MT of wheat vessel STAMFORD PIONEER is loading at Kandla Port since 09th April 2022.

International Market Update:

CBOT wheat future May contract settled up by 29 cents at \$10.81 per bushel after rising to \$10.91 per bushel. The rise in CBOT was with the view that US crop rating to go down.

As per USDA, 32% of the US wheat was rated good to excellent which is 2 percent higher compared to previous week, though the rating is still the poorest on record.

Morocco government is planning to build stockpiles of soft wheat which is needed for 5 months of domestic demand. They are also planning to increase durum wheat stocks. The local production this year was devasted by the drought and as a result 53% of the harvest is lost and only 21% of the crop is in good condition and 16% in average condition and 10% is rated as bad.

The Russian wheat export prices were stable last week due to strengthening of rouble against dollar, higher global prices for wheat in CBOT and Paris and weak demand domestically. Prices for wheat with 12.5% protein from the Black Sea ports were stable last week at \$368 FOB. Russia has exported 400,000 tonnes of grains last week, compared with 560,000 tonnes a week earlier.

Britain's wheat imports rose in February but it still remains down from last season's pace. Wheat imports for the february totalled 123,746 tonnes, up from 112,585 tonnes in January. Denmark was the largest supplier in February, shipping 64,390 tonnes followed by Germany with 40,222 tonnes.

Ukraine is expected to buy wheat from the 2022 harvest with an effort to provide cash to the producers as the Russian invasions limit export sales. It is expected that Ukraine will buy milling quality wheat at between \$181 and \$187 per tonne depending on quality. Ukraine's 2022 wheat harvest could decrease by almost 45% to 18.2 million tonnes due to war situations.

Algeria has issued an international tender to buy soft milling wheat for shipment to two ports only. The tender sought a nominal 50,000 tonnes. The deadline for submission of price offers in the tender is April 12th, with offers having to remain valid until April 13th. The wheat is sought for shipment in several periods from the main supply regions including Europe: May 1-10, May 11-20, May 21-31, June 1-10, June 11-20 and June 21-30. If sourced from South America or Australia, shipment is one month earlier.

Weather Outlook: Light fairly widespread/widespread rainfall accompanied with thunderstorm/lightning very likely over Kerala-Mahe and isolated/scattered rainfall over Tamilnadu-Puducherry-Karaikal, Lakshadweep area, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Coastal & South Interior Karnataka during next 5 days. Isolated very heavy rainfall likely over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal on 10th; and heavy rainfall likely over Kerala on 10th, 13th & 14th and over Tamilnadu on 11th April, 2022.
