

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

As per sources, In Punjab, the yield of wheat crop being reported is 13-14 quintals per acre compared to 20 quintals of yield previous year. The farmers are demanding for relaxation of quality specifications by FCI which includes 6% permissible for shriveled grains and moisture content up to 14%.

In Kaithal district, 30 percent of the procured wheat has been lifted. A total of 2.15 MT of wheat has arrived of which 2.10 MT of wheat has been procured by the government.

USDA is reporting record production for Indian wheat during marketing year 2022-23 at 110 MMT from 30.9 million hectares. This was higher than previous year's estimate of 109.6 MMT. USDA consider good climatic conditions responsible for bumper wheat harvest in these states. Agriwatch estimate the wheat production for the current year to be on lower side as the yield loss is being reported in most of the wheat producing states.

There are reports of rake shortage for transport of wheat. Currently the demand for rakes is as high as 50-60 rakes for the transport of wheat to Kolkata and Mumbai. But due to shortages, the rakes available is 2-3 rakes. If the shortage continues, we can expect a supply disruption in movement of stocks.

The wheat procurement activity will start in Himachal Pradesh from April 15th. And in Bihar the procurement is expected to start *from April 20th.*

The wheat arrival in the grain market is down by 58 per cent in Hisar district as compared to the corresponding period in the previous year. The farmers think that the wheat prices are likely to go up in the next few weeks. So, most of the farmers are stocking the new produce as of now. The international market has high demand for wheat from India due to the Russia-Ukraine war.

As of 11th April, the government procurement under RMS 2022-23 stood at 20.55 LMT. The procurement in Punjab is 7.85 LMT with a record 2.15 LMT purchase on 10th April. In Haryana, the procurement is 7.68 LMT and 4.96 LMT in Madhya Pradesh.

In Punjab, the wheat procurement is largely bought by the flour millers. As per the sources, the yield in Punjab is expected to fall by 10-20 percent. The quality of wheat arriving is not good as most of the grains have shrunken its size.

In Kota and Bundi, the quality of crop arriving is rated poor compared to previous year. The arrivals are already in peak in Rajasthan and is expected to reduce from April 17th. The yield in Rajasthan is expected to fall by 8-10% as per sources.

In Uttar Pradesh, the yield is expected to fall by 10-15% as per sources. There is no issue regarding moisture for the arrived crops, though the quality of crop being reported is average to poor. The poor quality is being purchased by the government and good quality going to trader's hands.

As per trade sources, 33,000 MT of wheat vessel GLOVIS MAGELLAN is loading at 10th April 2022. And 35,000 MT of wheat vessel AFRICAN VENTURE is loading at Kandla Port since 09th April 2022. And 28,000 MT of wheat vessel CHRISTIANA is loading at Kandla Port since 08th April 2022. And 55,000 MT of wheat vessel GLOBAL BRAVE is loading at Kandla Port since 08th April 2022. And 33,000 MT of wheat vessel HPC SUNRISE is loading at Kandla Port since 07th April 2022. And 32,000 MT of wheat vessel STAMFORD PIONEER is loading at Kandla Port since 09th April 2022.

International Market Update:

Egypt has confirmed that it is considering taking wheat from India this month. Generally, Egypt purchase wheat from Black Sea region due to its proximity, competitive prices and quality of wheat. Egypt is also in talks with USA, Argentina and France.

From November 2021 to first week of April, Morocco has imported 2.6 MMT of wheat. The wheat prices have also increased to \$510 per tonne in domestic market. The Moroccan government is removing wheat import duty in order to control wheat prices. In order to control the prices, they will import more and more wheat. France will be the first priority for Morocco as a source of wheat.

In France, for soft wheat, the 2022 area for spring wheat crop is pegged at 4.79 million hectares which is down by 3.9% compared to 2021 and 0.7% below the past 5-year average. Winter soft wheat sowings were revised up slightly to 4.77 million hectares from a previous estimate of 4.75 million hectares in February.

As per USDA, 32% of the US wheat was rated good to excellent which is 2 percent higher compared to previous week, though the rating is still the poorest on record.

Weather Outlook: Heat wave condition is expected in different pockets of India. Over East Madhya Pradesh it is expected on 13th, 16th and 17th, over Bihar on 13th and 14th.
