

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

In major markets, firm sentiments are seen and is expected to continue firm trend in coming days.

In Punjab, the percentage of shriveled grains are ranging between 10-20% which is way ahead of permissible limit of 6%. In Malwa region, the percentage is 20%, while in Bathinda and Kapurthala region it is between 10-12%. Higher percentage represents poor quality grains.

Till April 17th, government has procured 69.24 LMT of wheat which is down by 75.78 percent compared to previous year's procurement of 121.71 LMT. Largest procurement was done in Punjab with 32.17 LMT followed by Haryana with 27.76 LMT. In Madhya Pradesh 8.99 LMT of wheat was procured by the government.

In Haryana with good pace of procurement it is expected that the procurement will finish by April 30th. Last year the procurement went till May 15th.

Egypt has accepted India as the source of wheat supplier. They are planning to import 1 MMT of wheat from India and 0.24 MMT of wheat to be imported during the month of April.

Wheat purchases have reached a record 17 LMT in Punjab, the highest procurement in last 15 years. The wheat purchases by private traders have reached 1 LMT.

In Indore, the registration for wheat procurement has extended till 17th April 2022. Till now, not even 25% of the farmers is showing interest for the procurement. The procurement in Indore is expected to fall by 50% with 1.5 LMT expected against the target of 3LMT.

At Amritsar, on 13th April, 4309 MT of wheat has arrived out of which 3107 MT of wheat has been procured. A total of 6668 MT of wheat has arrived out of which 4916 MT of wheat has been procured. It is expected that the arrivals would increase from the coming week.

In Haryana, the arrivals are expected to fall by 20% though due to early harvesting the arrivals seems to be on higher side. The private players are also participating in the purchase with 10000 MT already purchased at prices above MSP.

As per sources, In Punjab, the yield of wheat crop being reported is 13-14 quintals per acre compared to 20 quintals of yield previous year. The farmers are demanding for relaxation of quality specifications by FCI which includes 6% permissible for shriveled grains and moisture content up to 14%.

International Market Update:

Russian wheat export prices rose last week due to active supplies from the Black Sea ports and due to higher global prices for wheat in CBOT. There are new deals, but not too many, and from limited number of countries: Turkey as prime destination, followed by Iran and Egypt. Prices for wheat with 12.5% protein content for supply in May from the Black Sea ports were up \$2 to \$370 FOB. Russia exported 630,000 tonnes of grains last week, compared with 400,000 tonnes a week earlier.

Iraq's production for current season is expected to fall by 50% compared to last season which is 500,000 MT less due to the ongoing drought conditions.

Soft wheat exports by European Union for 2021-22 has reached 20.63 MMT as of April 10th 2022. The exports were 21.42 MMT previous season during corresponding week.

Brazil's wheat crop has increased this year and would help Brazil to become one of the wheat exporting country though till last year Brazil's share for wheat exports was 1%, it is expected that it will increase. The USDA Brazilian attache has pegged Brazil's 2022-23 wheat crop at 8.8 MMT and exports at 3 MMT, both records and up a respective 14% and 7% on the year.

Currently China is the largest importer of Canada's wheat but it is likely that China will reduce its imports in order to shift to Russia and also due to higher influence of Canada on USA. The Canadian wheat crops are cheap and good quality.

<u>Weather Outlook</u>: Scattered to fairly widespread rainfall accompanied with thunderstorm/lightning/gusty winds very likely over Kerala-Mahe during next 5 days and isolated to scattered rainfall accompanied with thunderstorm/lightning/gusty winds over Tamilnadu-Puducherry-Karaikal, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh and Telangana during next 5 days.
