

**Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:**

**Currently, hundreds of trucks were laid with around 4 LMT of wheat which is meant for export to Bangladesh have been stuck at land ports in Bengal for at least three weeks as customs authorities are allegedly refusing their onward journey. The exporters are worried further delay in the transportation of the wheat will cause them losses of crores of rupees as the grain will start rotting because of rains.**

**Fodder prices have increased drastically in Rajasthan which was earlier prices at INR 200 per quintal which went as high as INR 1000 per quintal. The increase in fodder prices is due to lower acreage of wheat majority of which has been shifted to mustard.**

**Wheat procurement under the central pool in Rabi Marketing Season (RMS) 2022-23 stood at 184.58 LMT with the MSP value of Rs. 37,192.07 crore benefitting 17.50 lakh farmers.**

**As per sources, Turkey has rejected an Indian wheat consignment on phytosanitary concerns on May 29. The wheat consignment was detected with Indian Rubella disease and was rejected.**

**Punjab has contributed around 53% of the total wheat procured for the central pool as over 102 LMT crop had arrived in Punjab mandi's of which 96 LMT was purchased by the government agencies and the remaining over 6 LMT was purchased by private players.**

**In Haryana, only 40.72 LMT was procured by government compared to 84.93 LMT last year. In UP, the government procurement is just 2.46 LMT against 56.41 LMT last year. In MP, the government procurement is just 42.09 LMT this year against 128.16 LMT last year and in Rajasthan, the government procurement is just 1000 MT against 23.4 LMT last year.**

**As per NITI Aayog, the price rise in domestic market is inevitable as the international prices are already on higher side. The international wheat prices rose by almost 30-40 % and in case of India the rise is only about 6-7%.**

**As per sources, India has no immediate plans to lift a ban on wheat exports, but will continue to deal which are done directly with other governments.**

**As per USDA FAS report, in wheat the yield has reduced by 10-15%, decreasing India's wheat crop for 2022-23 MY at 99 MMT. Under the current market supply situation, India's wheat exports in MY 2022-23 would barely touch upon 6 MMT, compared to MY 2021-22 export of 8.5 MMT and MY 2022-23's initial projection of 10 MMT.**

**International Market Update:**

**As per ABARES, Australia's wheat output averaged at 24.8 MMT annually. Currently, Australian farmers have enjoyed all-time high wheat prices this year with record output giving huge advantage. Australian Premium White (APW) was quoted at USD\$440 per tonne FOB, slightly below a record price of USD\$460 per tonne FOB a few weeks ago.**

**Algeria bought around 90,000 MT of milling wheat in an international tender this week which covered two small ports, European traders said. The CIF cost for the wheat was expected to be \$480 per tonne.**

**As per Buenos Grain Exchange, Argentina's wheat planting area for the 2022-23 season is expected to be around 6.5 mha, down from 6.6 mha previously forecast. The exchange said the 100,000-hectare reduction on dry conditions in northern Argentina, with no rains seen in short term forecasts.**

**France's soft wheat crop condition has declined for a fifth consecutive week. An estimated 67% of the soft wheat crop was in good or excellent condition in the week to May 30, down from 69% the previous week. The rating fell by more than 20 percentage points in May as a hot spell exacerbated drought after low rainfall since the start of the year.**

**Algeria is expecting its wheat output to be at 3.2 MMT this season against 2 MMT in 2021. The country has wheat reserves sufficient for the next 10 months and it has imported 3 million tonnes so far and the imports are ongoing.**

**Bangladesh has received the lowest price offer of \$464.55 per tonne in an international tender to import 50,000 tonnes of wheat.**

**Chicago wheat futures fell, after Russia expressed readiness to unlock grain cargoes blocked in Ukrainian ports. Russia was ready to facilitate the unhindered export of grain from Ukrainian ports in coordination with Turkey.**

**Weather Outlook:** Fairly widespread/ widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy falls very likely over Northeast India and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during next 5 days. Isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall very likely over Assam & Meghalaya during 02nd-04th and over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 03rd-06th June. Isolated extremely heavy falls also likely over Meghalaya on 02nd & 03rd June.
