

## Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

Firm sentiment has been observed on Wednesday (25/May/23) in major Wheat cash markets. Wheat prices traded higher in Indore market by Rs. 50 per quintal at Rs.2350 per quintal.

Decreased flow of arrivals in major markets, increased buying interest of millers and higher holding by farmers in Rajasthan, U.P and Bihar have lent support to cash wheat markets. Major markets traded up by Rs 40 to 50 per quintal. and may move further up by Rs 40-50 more in coming weeks.

Millers' buying activity is likely to intensify in June as the festive season starts from July. South Indian millers have started adv. deals for mid-June and July, sensing drying up of supply from farmer's end. AgriWatch expects prices to trade steady to slightly firm in the upcoming week unless the government intervenes.

As per Reuters, India's wheat procurement in 2023 season could fall by a fifth from the initial estimate as government purchases have slowed down in the last few days after local prices increased in the market. The government has so far procured around 26.1 million tonne of wheat.

Although, the government agencies will keep the window open to buy from farmers until at least 30<sup>th</sup> June 23. Wheat prices in central India have risen by 5% in May month to Rs. 2,325 per 100 kg against the government buying price of Rs. 2,125 per 100kg.

## **International Market Update:**

The USDA's crop progress report for the week ending on May 21<sup>st</sup> indicates that 61% of winter wheat crops was headed which was 49% in previous week and 61% in previous year. The report also shows that 29% of the crop is currently in fair to excellent condition, while 22% in very poor to poor condition. As for spring wheat, 64% of planting has been completed so far this year, which is higher than the 48% completed during the same period last year.

According to Ukraine's Agriculture Ministry, as of 19 May '23, cumulative 2022-23 wheat exports totaled 15.1 MT (down 18pc from previous year). SovEcon have revised up 2023-24 Russian wheat production by 1.4MT to 88.0MT (104.2MT previous year).

Buenos Aires exchange has raised Wheat production by 45% as compared to previous year. They have further mentioned the increase of 3% in sowing area to 6.3 hectares.

**Total of around 27.17 MMT of Soft Wheat has been exported so far from European Union so far** till 14th May, 2023, as per data given by European Commission. It is up by 12% as compared to same period in previous year.
