HARYANA

Apart from meeting its own requirement for food grains, Haryana also contributes about 45 lakh tonnes of food grains to the Central Pool annually It is believed that agricultural production in Haryana has reached to a saturation level. In the state; State Agricultural Marketing Board has identified crop production zones – Shahabad for Potato, Karnal for Rice, Sirsa for Cotton, Mahendergarh for Onion, Rewari for Oilseeds & Pulses.
